High-end retail consignment in Chandler

Do you want new trends and designer labels in your closet? ...but you're on a budget? An innovative way of updating your wardrobe without breaking the bank is cleaning out your closet and doing retail consignment.

Retail Consignment

The consignee (the retailer) sells your stuff and pays the consignor (you) a portion of the proceeds from a sale. Payment is not made until and unless the item sells. A period of time is arranged, but if the item doesn't sell the owner can reclaim it (there is a time limit) or have the seller donate it. People consign gently used clothes and accessories with no stains/damages/defects. Two high end consignment shops in Chandler stand out.

Plato's Closet

Just south of Warner on Alma School Road, Plato's Closet buys and sells the latest looks in brand names for teens and twenty somethings. They specialize in items that are current and have been in the retail stores within the past year and a half (sizes 0-16 for girls and 28-40 for guys). Plato's Closet has a vast selection of designer styles at 70% off mall retail prices.

My Sisters Closet

At Alma School Road and Queen Creek Road, My Sisters Closet is a recycled designer apparel shop geared toward the sophisticated crowd. They don't buy items more than four to five years old, but vintage, antique, or retro items are exceptions. My Sisters Closet has a boutique style establishment with all the hottest labels, 60-95% below retail.

The bonus with consigning at My Sisters Closet is that you can use your proceeds at their other two stores, My Sisters Attic, a recycled home furnishing store, and Well Suited, a men's resale store.
