Phoenix locals Ann and Jennifer Siner share my love of resale shopping so much that they decided to open their own shop and have transformed the resale shopping experience from what they call the "three d's – dark, dirty, and dingy; into the there c's- cute, clean, and current."

And believe me, the sisters succeeded.

Currently there are 3 My Sisters Closet Locations- the first store in Phoenix, one in Scottsdale, and another in Chandler that resell fabulous hand me down clothing from other AZ locals.

I love this store because the buyers here have great taste; everything they sell is classy, current, and a lot of the time, designer.
Best of all, many of the prices for 60%-90% off of the original retail.

This is also one of the only consignment shops that I've found that will buy my old jewelry, like loose earrings without their tags.
